1. CV (*updated and including picture*)
2. Master degree certificate or similar
3. Short outline of the PhD research proposal (*1 page excluding references*) according to the provided template (*see addendum*)

Highly recommended:

4. English language skills – IELTS 6.5 (applicants who hold an IELTS 6.5 or equivalent certificate will be given priority)
5. Acceptance letter from a Dutch university (PhD students who hold an admission letter from a Dutch University will be given priority)

All submitted documents should be in English
